Currachs have been used in Ireland for thousands of years.

**RECIPES**

Irish Brown Soda Bread By: Andrea Doyle

"This is the real thing! Because it must only be handled very lightly, it can never be made in a bread machine."

Prep Time: 10 Minutes  
Cook Time: 45 Minutes  
Ready In: 55 Min

**Ingredients**  
4 cups whole wheat flour 1 cup bread flour  
1/3 cup rolled oats 1 teaspoon baking soda 1  
teaspoon salt 2 1/2 cups buttermilk

**Directions**  
Preheat oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C). Lightly grease two baking sheets. In a large bowl, stir together whole wheat flour, white flour, rolled oats, baking soda and salt. Gently mix in the buttermilk until a soft dough is formed. Knead very lightly. Divide dough into 4 pieces; form into rounded flat loaves. Mark each loaf with an 'X' and place on prepared baking sheets. Bake in preheated oven until golden brown, about 30 to 45 minutes.

Deirdre, our Irish Historian, spoke about the Irish flag. The national flag of Ireland is a vertical tricolor of green (at the flagpole), white, and orange. It is also known as the Irish Tricolor. The green represents the Gaelic tradition of Ireland and the orange represents the followers of William of Orange in Ireland, with white representing peace, or a truce, between them. Did you know that in 1848, Thomas Meagher visited France to help with their rebellion and was inspired to create the Irish Tricolor? It was not until the Easter Rising of 1916, when it was raised above the General Post Office in Dublin, that the Tricolor came to be regarded as the national flag. In 1937, the Irish Tricolor was given constitutional status under the 1937 Constitution of Ireland.
